¹Yachting Members have all the rights and privileges afforded to Regular Members except they may not vote or hold office. Yachting Members are expected to actively participate in Club sailing events, and to sail under the Club burgee when participating in away regattas.

²Independent Junior Members have all the rights and privileges afforded to Regular Members except they may not vote, hold office, park their car in the yard, or extend club privileges to guests.

³Members must already hold a Regular Membership to become an Associate Non-Resident Member or Non-Resident Member. Dues for these classifications are paid annually.

⁴Members must already hold a Regular Membership to become an Anchor Member. Anchor Members retain all the rights and privileges afforded to Regular Members except they may not vote or hold office. Anchor Members must sell their membership.

⁵Monthly dues INCLUDE: \$8 per month for Capital Reserve Fund and \$8 per month for 20/20 Fund.
