¹ Yachting members have all the rights and privileges accorded to Regular Members except they may not vote, or hold office. Yachting members are expected to actively participate in club sailing events, and to sail under the club burgee when participating in away regattas.

² Independent Junior members have all the rights and privileges accorded to Regular Members except they may not vote, hold office, park their car in the yard or extend club privileges to guests.

³ You must be a Regular member to become an Associate Non-Resident Member or Non- Resident Member. Dues for these classifications are paid annually.

⁴ You must be a Regular member to become an Anchor Member. Anchor members must sell their membership, but will retain all the rights and privileges accorded to Regular Members except they may not vote, or hold office.

⁵ Monthly dues INCLUDE: \$7 per month for Capital Reserve Fund and \$7 per month for 20/20 Fund.
